Parish Council Meeting: Parish Council will meet on Monday, Jan. 16 at 7:00 p.m. in the rectory.

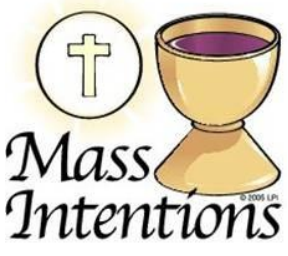
