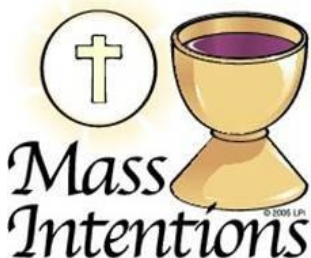
Holy Cross News:
