onto <https://lnmv.formed.org>.

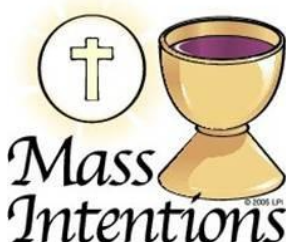
FIRST RECONCILIATION: There will be a mandatory short program after
